Art & Science Summer Camp Policies and Guidelines

Hours of Operation

Monday—Friday 8:00-5:00

- Signing your child in and out is required daily.
- Campers may not come before 8:00 and need to be picked up no later than 5:00
- All campers need to be at camp no later than 8:30. Earliest pickup is 4:30.
- **No childcare before/after camp**
- Late pick-up charge \$5.00 per minute.

Payment Policy

Enrollment in camp is guaranteed upon receipt of deposit. Camp fees are as follows:

- A non-refundable \$25 per session registration fee is due upon registering for Art & Science Summer Camp. Registration for one session is \$25 and two sessions is \$50 (cash or check).
- **Tuition payments are due on the first day of camp session paid through the ACH payment portal. ACH or cash are the only forms of payment accepted for payment.**

Cancellation Policy

Due to the finite number of spaces available, parents are encouraged to sign their child up *only for the sessions they are certain their child will be able to attend*. You are financially responsible for tuition, unless four weeks' notice is given for cancellation.

Illness Policy

In order to protect the other children and the staff, your child may not attend camp if he or she has had diarrhea, vomiting, pink eye and/or fever accompanied by behavior changes or other signs or symptoms of illness within a 24-hour period. If a child should become ill while at camp, the child's parents will be notified immediately. The child will be made comfortable, but no medications will be administered without **written** consent from the parent. **If a child has diarrhea, vomits, gets pink eye or a fever while at camp they may not return to camp the following day.** Your child must be symptom free for 24 hours before returning to camp. The camp director has the discretion to send a child home at any time if she/he thinks that it is necessary. This is based on the child's ability to participate. The environment will be cleaned with disinfectant on a routine basis.

What to Bring...

Please be sure your child is prepared daily. **Pack the following into a large easy-to-wear backpack. Please clearly label all items brought to camp.**

- Camp shirt (Each Camper will receive a camp field trip shirt.)
- Tennis Shoes
- Sunscreen
- Swimsuit and Towel
- Bag lunch in an insulated lunch box with ice pack (no refrigeration system is provided)
- Two-Three Snacks
- **(2) Plastic or metal 24oz water bottles.**

*****Please do not bring any items from home that are not on this list. Lakewood Montessori will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items.*****

Release of Liability

In no event shall Lakewood Montessori, its owners, directors, employees, or volunteers be liable for any direct, indirect, punitive, incidental, special or consequential damages, or any damages arising from anything other than our sole negligence in student supervision or care during an event taking place away from normal school premises.

This agreement is intended to bind Lakewood Montessori and students' parents, or guardians, during occasional special activities and/or events. Examples include museum/zoo/garden field trips, picnic lunches and transportation to & from the same.

Transportation to and from specified activities and events will be managed by contract with professional public transportation services.

Lakewood Montessori will take appropriate steps to investigate and assure that off site facility owners and transportation providers are appropriately skilled in working events contemplating young children. In addition, we will always provide supervision appropriate to each event and circumstance for those students participating in our programs.
